Our transportation program goes beyond merely providing rides. We offer a gateway to independence, ensuring that seniors can access vital medical appointments, grocery stores, and social activities without the burden of isolation.

Program Details

- Services are at no-cost to our clients. Focus is on clients that are typically alone and frail, chronically ill, homebound, and/or may be dependent on a caregiver.
- Rides are provided to ambulatory as well as clients using assistive devices i.e., cane, walker, wheelchair, scooter, or oxygen.

Rider Eligibility

- All programs at Helping Hands of Vegas Valley serve seniors, age 60 and over, who live in Nevada.
- All potential participants will be assessed for eligibility.
- Completion of the Registration Form
- **Program eligibility, income requirements, and service areas may vary depending on the program the participant wishes to receive services from.

Client Requirements

- Transportation is provided to approved, assessed clients 60 years of age or older.
- Clients must provide proof of Nevada residency and complete an income statement

Program Rules

- Each eligible and registered client is allowed to schedule 2 rides per week
- 5 mile radius for personal errands
- 15 mile radius for medical appointments

Scheduling Rides

Schedule up to 6 months in advance with a 2 week minimum for reservations
